Field Technician

- New Cell Deployments (NCDs), new sector additions and RF related troubleshooting.
- Identifying alarms and diagnosing the issue.
- Proficiency in test gear equipment.

- Performing and implementing all work done to the CIK standards and quality required by customer.
- Abiding and implementing all company and OSHA safety standards.
- Reporting and maintaining proper inventory counts.
